

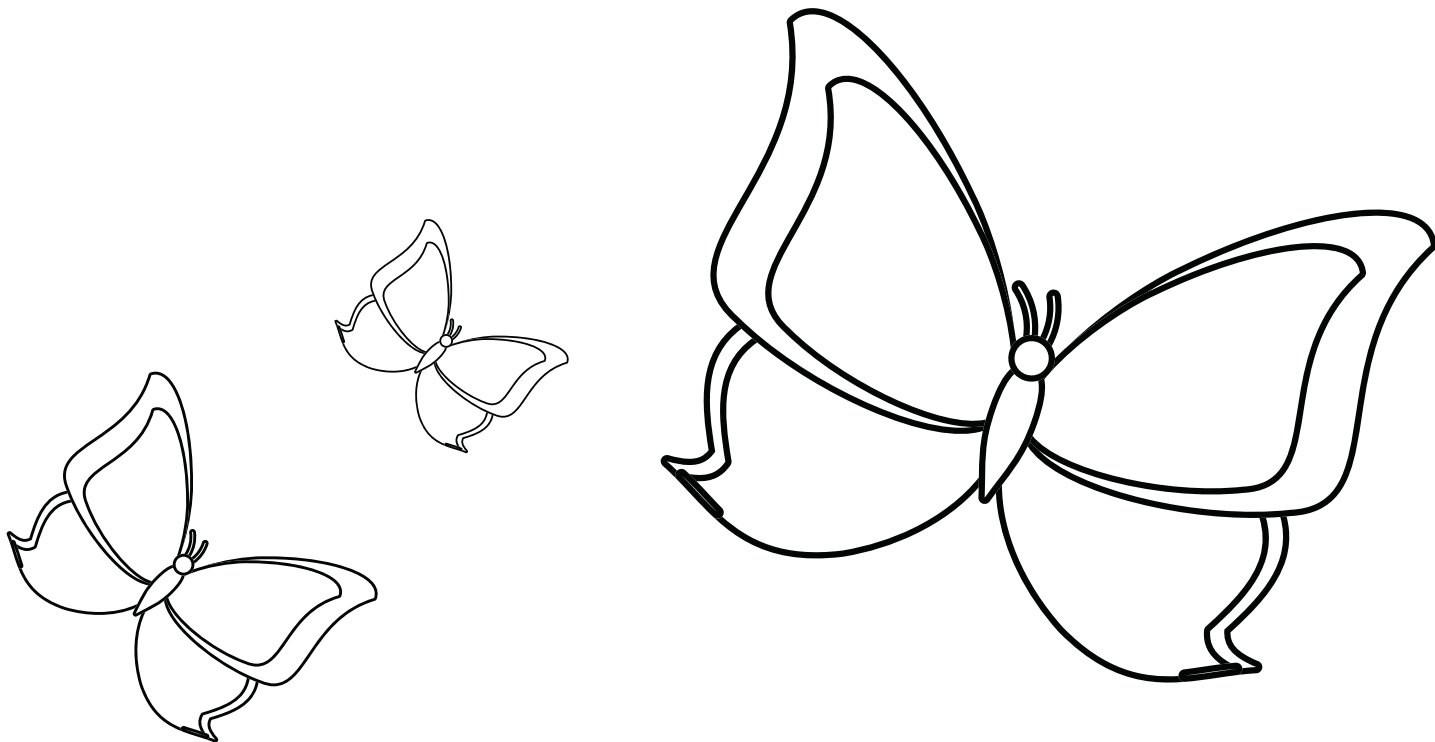


Fourth Sunday of Easter | John 10:1-10
